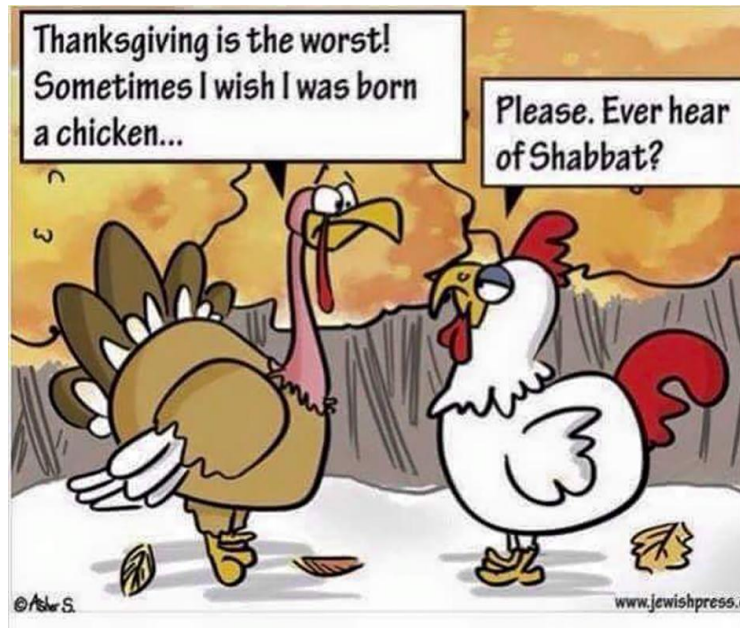

charitable rollover gift as a qualified charitable distribution...

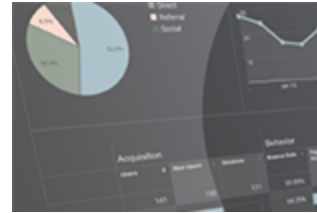

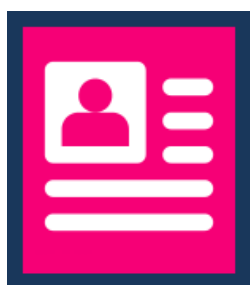
